The **San Pedro Bay Historical Society (SPBHS)** is proud to offer one (1) \$1000 scholarship to a 2021 graduating college-bound senior of San Pedro High School, either flagship or Olguin campus. The scholarship is given in memory of Mitchell (Mitch) C. Mardesich, a former social studies teacher at San Pedro High for 25 years (1969-1994), and a charter member of the San Pedro Bay Historical Society.

The theme for the 2021 scholarship is “**My San Pedro.**” We want you to **show or tell us what is important or special to you about San Pedro.** The submission may be in the form of an essay, poem, painting, photographs with captions, video (no longer than 5 minutes), or song (include audio recording).

Requirements:

- College bound senior graduating in June, 2021.
- For an essay or poem, the format should be a pdf, 12-point Times font, double-spaced, with one-inch margins. No more than 750 words. Videos, no longer than 5 minutes. Songs must include an audio recording. **Any copyrighted material used must have accompanying attribution information.** The SPBHS is not responsible for lost or damaged entries. Do not submit anything of great monetary value. **All submissions shall become the property of the SPBHS.**
- Submissions and the Applicant Information page may be submitted electronically via email or mailed to our mailing address.
- The \$1,000 will be deposited in the college account of the winner when college attendance is verified.
- Copying from the Internet or any other source will result in disqualification.
