Mardesich, a former social studies teacher at San Pedro High for 25 years (1969-1994), and a charter member of the San Pedro Bay Historical Society.

Pictorial or illustrated essay, no more than ten letter-sized pages. **Any copyrighted material used must have accompanying attribution information and required release if necessary.** The SPBHS is not responsible for lost or damaged entries. **All submissions shall become the property of the SPBHS to be used, if we so choose, in our advertising.**

- Copying from the Internet or any other source will result in disqualification.
- The SPBHS reserves the right to not offer the scholarship if no qualified applications are received.
